## Jure 2010 in Frankfurt is moving closer DIPF is involved in organizing the conference

The <u>JURE 2010</u> will take place from 19th to 22nd July at the Campus Westend of the Goethe-University with approximately 250 participants. JURE is the conference for *Junior Researchers* of EARLI (European Association for Research on Learning and Instruction). Jana Höhler at the <u>German Institute</u> for International Educational Research (DIPF) and Saskia Kistner at the Goethe-University in Frankfurt have chaired the international organizing conference committee consisting of 5 other PhD-students from Finland, Netherlands and Belgium since November 2008.

JURE is a network dedicated to the interests of all junior researchers of EARLI. The term "junior researchers" includes PhD-students and graduates who received their doctorate within the last two years. The primary aim of JURE is to represent and to support research students in matters of interest. Furthermore, learning from one another and interaction among junior as well as senior researchers within an international scope are significant goals for JURE.

This year's conference topic is "Connecting Diverse Perspective on Learning and Instruction: A Conference of Synergy". JURE 2010 aims to connect diverse perspectives in research on learning and instruction with the intention of exploring and discussing comprehensive and interdisciplinary ideas. By connecting these diverse perspectives, young researchers can broaden their view and learn from each other.

The Conference includes different presentation formats: professional development courses, paper sessions, ICT demonstrations, interactive poster and round table sessions. The keynote speakers of the conference are: Professor Helen Cowie (UK Observatory for the Promotion of Non-Violence; UK), Professor Benö Csapó (University of Szeged, Institute of Education; Hungary) and Dr. Tamara van Gog (Open University Netherlands). On the last day of the conference these three keynote speakers are engaged in a controversial debate moderated by Professor Eckhard Klieme (DIPF).
